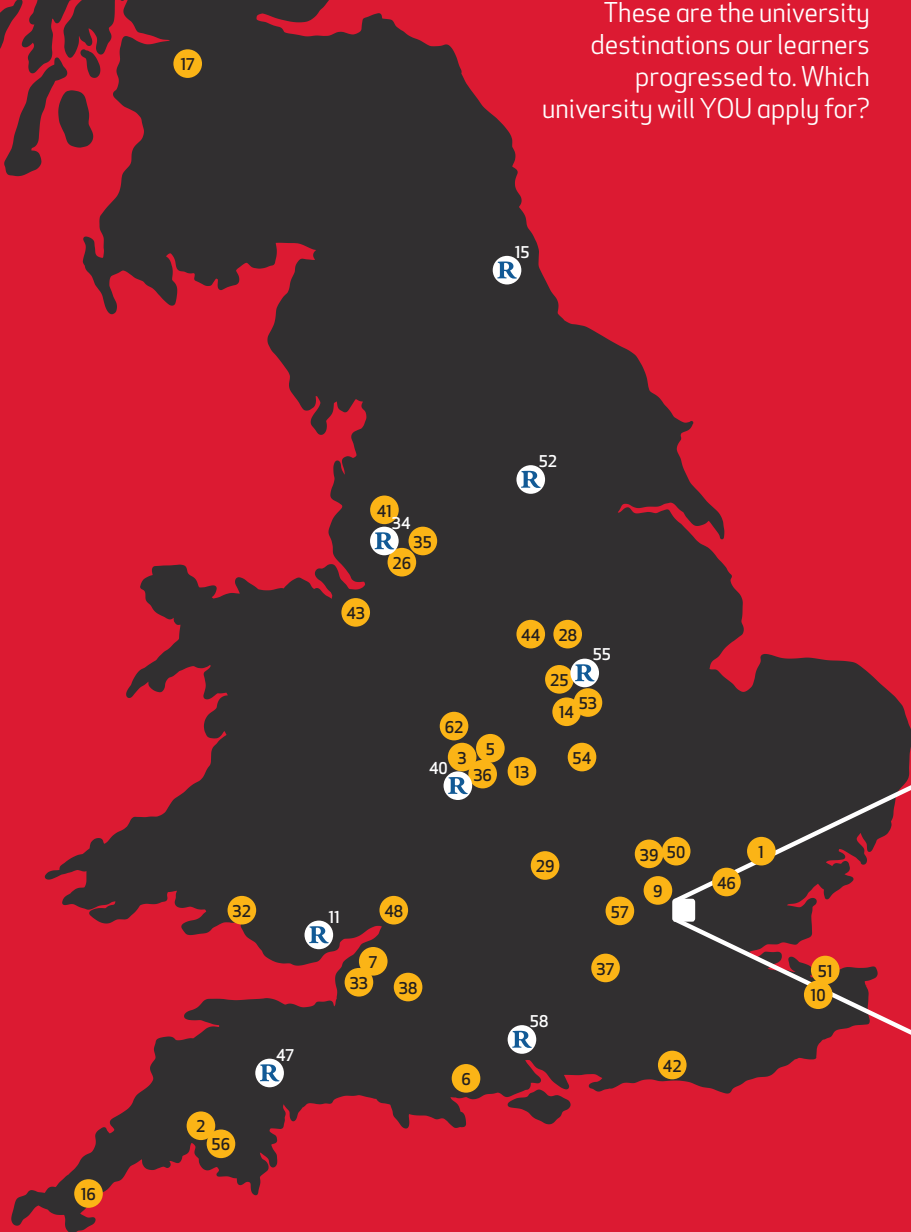
PROGRESS IN COLLEGE

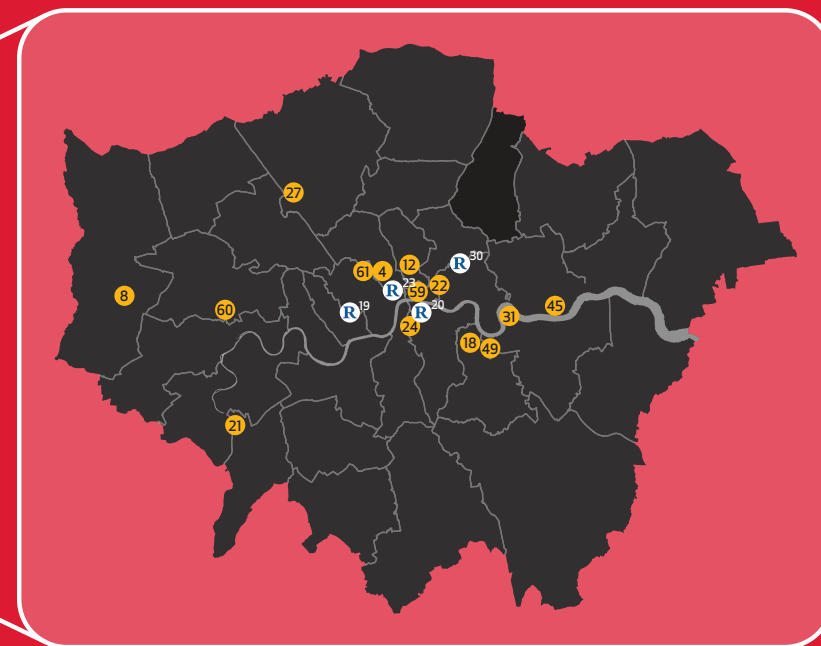

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You will need at least 6 GCSEs at Grade 6 and above including English and maths. If you choose to study mathematics you will require a Grade 7 in GCSE mathematics.

Your suitability for A Level study will be measured against your predicted achievement at GCSE, and your commitment to study measured through references from your current school and your current level of attendance.

STEVENAGE-1

What are T Levels?

T Levels bring classroom and work placement together on a course designed with employers and businesses to give you the skills and knowledge employers are looking for.

They follow GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A-Levels.

You will study one T Level during your two years at college.

T Level breakdown

As part of the T Level course (and subject to the T Level you choose) you will participate in a minimum of 9 weeks work experience (industry placement) where you will work with a subject-relevant employer to gain invaluable industry knowledge.

FULL T LEVEL QUALIFICATION

20% - INDUSTRY PLACEMENT

80% - TECHNICAL QUALIFICATION

20% - 50% CORE MODULES

Knowledge of underpinning concepts, theories, principles and core workplace skills relevant to your T Level subject.

50% - 80% SPECIALISM

Knowledge and skills further developed around your chosen specialism.

GCSE

Welcome to GCSEs

Waltham Forest College now delivers GCSE courses for 16-18 learners, for those who have just missed out on Grade 4s in their GCSE exams and those who have just recently entered the country.

The programme consists of a range of subjects that can be taken in combination with each other to have a complement of GCSEs that lead towards a complete package enabling progression to Level 3 study.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this study programme, students must have a minimum of Grade 3 in English (Language and/or Literature) and maths.

Students must be able to demonstrate a positive attitude to their prior studies measured through a student reference and their prior attendance.

What can I study?

All students on this pathway must study:

English Language | Mathematics

Students will then be asked to rank their choices from the following:

Art | Business | Citizenship | Combined Science (Biology, Chemistry & Physics)
Computer Science | English Literature | Physical Education | Sociology

Entry Level courses have no formal qualification requirement. You will be asked to attend an interview to check your suitability.

LEVEL 1

4 GCSEs at grades 1-2 including English and maths or successful completion of Entry Level course.

LEVEL 2

4 GCSEs at grade 3+ including English and maths or successful completion of Level 1 course.

LEVEL 3

4 GCSEs at grade 4+ including English and maths or successful completion of Level 2 course.

ENGLISH & MATHS

To maximise your employment and earning potential when you leave education, you are required to have at least a Grade 4 in your English and maths GCSEs. If you don't achieve this at school you will have the opportunity to study it with us.
